I also need to read a bit in the Wreck Diver manual, as I am doing my Specialty rating while here in Grenada – the wreck capital of the Caribbean! More diving tomorrow!

Top five dives



- 1. Bianca C** - the 'Titanic of the Caribbean' is the wreck of a cruise liner at 40m to 30m, a challenging deep dive for experienced divers.
- 2. Shark Reef** - Atlantic reef with good current, maximum depth 20m, nurse sharks, turtles, crabs and pelagic.
- 3. Flamingo Bay** - Critter capital of Grenada; beautiful reef dive, depth range from 10m to 30m, a photographer's delight.
- 4. Hema 1** - wreck dive in the Atlantic, depth of 30m attracts pelagic, eagle rays, turtles, sharks, barracuda and more.
- 5. Purple Rain** - beautiful reef dive, gentle current, maximum depth to 28m, known for its huge schools of Creole wrasse.



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
